ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday was fully steady to \$1.00 stronger than last week notes Canfax, with sales reported from \$430.00-\$433.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax notes: "Buying interest has been noted from all three Western Canadian packers. To a certain degree the cattle feeder is in a tough position. Historically strong prices and strong basis levels would suggest this is a good time to sell the cattle. However, on the flipside of the coin, the economics of adding weight to the cattle is still justifiable as the cattle feeder is getting paid for every pound they are putting on the cattle." Business should continue today.
