Alberta direct trade this week has seen light trade, with dressed sales mostly reported at \$438.00/cwt delivered, steady to \$6.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Traded cattle are scheduled for delivery between the week of June 10 and June 24. Fed cattle prices have increased in 9 of the past 10 weeks. rallying near \$30.00/cwt over that period. This week, new record highs were established.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw around 4,000 head of cattle traded between Texas and Kansas yesterday, with live sales ranging from \$185.00-186.00/cwt, down \$1.00-2.00/cwt from the previous week. In Iowa, dressed sales ranged from \$298.00-304.00/cwt, steady to \$2.00/cwt softer. Today, live sales in Nebraska were reported at \$190.00/cwt, steady with prices earlier this week and \$2.00/cwt lower than last week. At the end of April, total beef in cold storage was 5% lower than last year. Weekly export data indicates that US pork sales remain strong, with some of the highest export volumes of the year. Export sales to Mexico have bene continue to be strong.
