## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was scattered from Wednesday to Friday. Dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska ranged from \$298.00-304.00/cwt, steady to \$3/cwt Iower than the previous week. Live sales in the Northern US were from \$190.00-193.00/cwt, which is \$2.00/cwt weaker. Sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$186.00/cwt, \$1/cwt softer. Late last week, choice beef cutout values reached annual highs. With Father's Day approaching, retailers should be actively covering their needs. In the corn market, the December corn contract closed 20 cents per bushel lower last week and is trading lower today as well, not far from the contract lows of \$4.40 per bushel on February 23<sup>rd</sup>.
