ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Monday saw light trade with dressed sales at \$433.00/cwt delivered. This light test of the market does not set a market trend. This week's showlist volumes are smaller than last week's. For the week ending June 1st, Western Canadian carcass weights averaged 867 lbs, reaching a new annual low. Canadian fed cattle shipments to the US have decreased in recent weeks, which is expected given that Alberta's fed prices have been higher than those in the US. It was not too long-ago Canadian fed cattle shipments were running around 10,000-11,000 head per week, but now they are closer to 4,000 head per week. Asking prices start out at \$445.00/cwt delivered.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report, and significant trade will likely be delayed until the second half of this week. Showlist volumes have been reported smaller with the largest week-over-week declines in fed supplies reported in the Northern feeding states. US pork exports in April were 9% higher than last year, while shipments to China have decreased, strong exports to South Korea and Japan have compensated. In April, pork export volumes to Mexico were the highest on record, with Mexico accounting for over a third of total US pork exports.
