





ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade this week saw softer price tone as the week progressed, and delivery dates are starting to extend. On Thursday, fed cattle sales in Alberta and Saskatchewan were reported at \$433.50 to \$438.00/cwt delivered, which is \$2.00 to \$7.00/cwt lower compared to the previous week. Cattle traded were scheduled for delivery during the weeks of July 8th and July 15th. The weighted average prices for steer and heifers closed the week \$1.00 to \$2.00/cwt lower. This week's Alberta fed cash-to-future basis was reported at +\$11.19/cwt for the middle of June, this is the third strongest basis on record. When comparing with similar or strong basis years like 2015 and 2021, in 2015 the Alberta fed cash-to-basis in June averaged +\$11.51/cwt but weakened to -\$3.03/cwt in July. In 2021 basis levels went from +\$16.03/cwt in June to +\$0.63/cwt in July.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw around 5,000 head of cattle traded between Texas and Kansas yesterday, with live sales ranging from \$185.00/cwt to \$186.00/cwt, which is steady with Wednesday's prices and \$1.00 to \$2.00/cwt higher than last week. Dressed sales in lowa and Nebraska ranged from \$301.00/cwt to \$307.00/cwt, \$1.00 to \$6.00/cwt stronger than last week. Live sales in the Northern feeding states were from \$192.00/cwt to \$195.00/cwt, \$2.00 to \$5.00/cwt higher. Today the market tone is sounding stronger, with live bids reported up to \$197.00/cwt in Nebraska. Northern fed prices are on track to set new record highs this week. Stronger cash prices have supported the live cattle complex. US feeder index did set new record highs closing over \$255.00/cwt.
