#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw no new trade to report. Showlist volumes are larger than the previous week. Last week on a cash-to-cash basis, Alberta fed prices were at \$5.50/cwt discount against the Nebraska market, while Alberta cow prices were at \$2.75/cwt premium against the US market. This week's cash offering asking prices are reported to be around \$440.00+/cwt delivered. Canfax released its June 1st cattle on feed report last Friday. Feedlot placements for the month of May were 17% lower than last year. The one surprise over the past two reports has been the elevated heifer placements. For the month of May, heifer placements were larger than a year ago while steer placements were smaller. June 1st, cattle on feed inventories are below last year, this is the smallest June 1st on feed inventory since 2018. Cattle on feed for 120+ days is 10% below the five-year average.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Oklahoma yesterday with live sales at \$188.00/cwt, which is \$2.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Showlist volumes have been reported larger in all four major feeding states, with the Northern states experiencing the largest weekly jump in fed cattle numbers. Retail and food service business over Father's Day weekend is sounding good and fill in business has supported the beef complex. Additionally, some last minute buying for the July 4th holiday is also taking place. Choice cutout values closed \$0.50/cwt higher setting new annual highs yesterday. Cattle feeding margins are positive, there are some estimates cattle being marketed around \$400/head positive.
