Alberta direct trade was quiet yesterday. This week bids are starting out at \$435.00/cwt. Feed gain is still economical, lessened the urgency to sell. Increased carcass weights continue to support production. For the week ending June 14th, steer carcass weights in the West averaged 890 lbs, 37 lbs heavier than the same week last year.

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Iowa yesterday at \$195.00/cwt live. This light test of the market does not establish a trend. Today, packer interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of the week. USDA released its weekly crop progress report yesterday. Conditions deteriorated slightly, with corn acreage rated good or excellent at 69%, down from 72% from the previous week. Boxed beef prices remain strong, with choice at \$323.80/cwt at midday.
