ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Monday saw no new trade to report. Showlist volumes are smaller than the previous week. Alberta fed prices last week were at an \$11.00/cwt discount against the Nebraska market, for mid-July this is the weakest cash-to-cash basis since 2005. This week asking prices on cash offering are starting out at \$435.00/cwt delivered.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report, buying interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of the week. Showlist volumes are smaller in all four major feeding states with the largest week over week declines in the Northern feeding states. Asking prices are expected to start out at \$192.00/cwt in the South and \$200.00/cwt in the North. USDA latest cattle on feed report shows that July 1st on feed numbers is up 1% from last year. The report should be viewed as neutral to slightly positive as feedlot placements came in below expectations. In June feedlot placements were 7% lower than the previous year with the largest year-over-year declines in Kansas. Over the past three months feedlot placements are 133,000 head lower than last year. This is the smallest second quarter placement volume since 2016.
