ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw asking prices reported in the low \$430's/cwt delivered. This week Alberta and Saskatchewan showlist volumes are steady with the previous week and are 5% higher than last year. Over the past four weeks Canadian slaughter cattle exports for cows and fed cattle totaled just below 40,000 head, 56% larger than last year. There has been on going labour talks with Canadian National Railway and Canadian Pacific Kansas City, with the earliest possible rail strike being August 22nd.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw very light trade reported in lowa yesterday with live sales at \$191.00/cwt, traded \$2.00/cwt lower than last week. Today business remains quiet and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start around \$190.00/cwt in the South and \$196.00/cwt in the North. This week the four state show list volumes is smaller with the largest week over week declines in fed supplies noted in the Southern feeding states.
