



The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade in the North yesterday with live sales at \$190.00/cwt, \$3.00/cwt lower than last week. Dressed sales were reported at \$298.00/cwt, \$6.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Today live sales in the South are reported at \$185.00/cwt, \$1.00-\$2.00/cwt lower than last week. In the Northern feeding states, live sales are reported at \$190.00/cwt, \$3.00/cwt lower. Dressed sales were at \$298.00/cwt, \$6.00/cwt lower than last week's weighted average. The all-fresh beef retail price for the month of July was reported at \$8.15/lb, a new record high.
