### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw no new trade to report. Asking prices is reported at \$412.00+/cwt delivered. Showlist volumes are larger than the previous week. Since late September, the Canadian dollar has declined over 100 basis points while live cattle futures have strengthened. On a cash-to-cash basis, Alberta cows have been trading at a \$15.00/cwt premium against the US market, the largest premium since the summer of 2023.
