**Alberta direct trade** last week saw lives sales in the Northern feeding states from \$187.00-\$188.00/cwt, traded steady to \$1.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Dressed sales were reported at mostly \$296.00/cwt, fully steady. In the South, live sales were reported from \$186.00-\$187.00/cwt, steady to \$1.00/cwt stronger. USDA revised corn exports 25 million bushels higher. Since early October, the December corn contract has dropped nearly 30 cents per bushel.
