U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade today saw dressed bids reported up to \$310.00/cwt in the Nebraska, \$3.00/cwt higher than the previous week. While live bids In the Northern feeding states are reported at \$198.00/cwt, this might be from a regional packer. In the Southern feeding states live sales range from \$195.00-\$196.00/cwt, \$3.00-\$4.00/cwt stronger than last week. Front-end feeder cattle contracts are trading 200+ points higher, the highest point since March. There has been report from weather networks that could be supporting the futures market "Dangerously cold weather from the Artic is forecast to hit the U.S. next week, with potentially record-breaking low temperatures expected in some areas".
