ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw no new trade to report. Showlist volume is reported larger than the previous week. Asking prices have been reported around \$440.00+/cwt delivered. Last week on a cash-to-cash basis, Alberta fed prices were at a \$30.00/cwt discount against the Nebraska market. For the month of January, this is the weakest basis level on record. Western Canadian fed processing totaled 2.1 million head in 2024, 16,300 head below last year, this is the smallest fed processing since 2020.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade aw light trade reported in Iowa yesterday with live sales reported at \$200.00/cwt, fully steady with the previous week. Cash prices are currently at a premium to all 2025 live cattle contracts. Showlist volumes has been reported larger in all four major feeding states. Today, business remains quiet and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to be around \$200.00/cwt live in the South and \$202.00/cwt live in the North. Negotiations between the International Longshoremen's association and port employers are scheduled to resume today, as the current contract is set to expire in mid-January.
