

### Comments for the week ending October 31, 2024

Fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week at 248 head, were down 8 head from the previous week and 185 head smaller than the same time last year. Fed steers sold from \$225.80-\$250.35/cwt averaging \$239.53/cwt, down \$2.61/cwt from the previous week's trade but \$8.85/cwt higher than year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$219.94-\$245.54/cwt averaging \$235.03/cwt, up \$4.25/cwt from last week and \$1.25/cwt higher than last year. Auction markets reported fed steers and heifers sold steady on Tuesday October 29th. On Thursday October 31st, fed steers and heifers sold \$3.00/cwt higher.

So far this week, dressed sales in Ontario have been reported from \$406-411/cwt delivered, steady to \$5/cwt higher than the previous week. The Ontario cash-to-futures basis, at -\$16.31/cwt, is the weakest so far this year. Eastern Canadian processing was down 13% YTD with steers down 10% and heifers down 9%, cows down 25% and bulls down 37%. For the week ending October 26th, Eastern Canadian processing was 2.5% below year ago levels and 3.4% below the five-year average. For the week ending October 19th, Eastern Canadian fed cattle and cow exports to the US were 3,430 head, 9% above last year and 52% above the five-year average. YTD exports are up 29.9% from last year.

Cull cow receipts sold through auction markets this week were 2,111 head, up 177 head from last week and down 770 head from last year. Cows were selling from \$118.25-\$173.39/cwt averaging \$143.71/cwt, down \$6.36/cwt from last week and up \$39.79/cwt from last year. Beef cow prices sold from \$116.85-\$176.66/cwt averaging \$148.36/cwt, down \$12.39/cwt from the previous week's trade but \$35.91/cwt above year ago prices. Auction markets reported on Monday October 28th, cows sold actively at steady prices.

Larger receipts of 9,063 stocker and feeder cattle sold through Ontario auction markets this week up 1,404 head from the previous week and 1,413 head more than the same week last year. Auction markets reported last week good quality stockers sold at steady prices. On Wednesday October 30th, feeder cattle sold actively at higher prices. Stockers sold at softer prices on October 31st. Actual average prices collected this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs trading \$14.45/cwt higher than last week on average, 500-600 lbs up \$19.73/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$24.74/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$18.93/cwt, 800-900 lbs were up \$5.88/cwt, steers 900-1000 lbs up \$6.69/cwt and steers 1000 lbs plus averaged \$6.84/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$2.19/cwt from last week on average, 400-500 lbs down \$0.17/cwt, 500-600 lbs down \$2.64/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$5.28/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$0.22/cwt, 800-900 lbs up \$4.15/cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$12.77/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs up \$5.28/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$0.22/cwt, 800-900 lbs up \$4.15/cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$12.77/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. The calf run is in full gear, with calves rallying.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$403.75/cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, which is up \$0.41/cwt from the previous week's trade on average.

Alberta fed trade last week saw light trade develop with weighted average fed prices closing the week fully steady. Dressed sales were reported from \$403-408/cwt delivered. Butcher cows traded \$2-4/cwt lower through commercial auction facilities. On Wednesday October 30<sup>th</sup>, light trade developed with dressed sales and bids reported from \$403-405/cwt delivered, steady to \$3/cwt lower than the previous week. Light receipts of Western Canadian fed cattle have been marketed South. Western Canadian fed processing for the week ending October 26th was 37,062 head down 17% from last year. Canadian fed cattle and cow exports to the US for the week ending October 19th totaled 12,551 head, up 24% from last year.

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska from \$298-302/cwt (mostly \$298/cwt), \$2/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in the Northern feeding states were from \$190-192/cwt, \$2-3/cwt higher while Southern regions traded from \$189-191/cwt, \$2/cwt higher. Choice cutout values have strengthened throughout October and are \$15/cwt higher than a year ago. On Wednesday October 30th, light trade was reported in all four major feeding states. Dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska ranged from \$296-298/cwt, \$2-4/cwt lower than the previous week. Live sales in the Northern feeding states were from \$188-190/cwt \$2/cwt softer. Sales in Texas and Kansas were at mostly \$190/cwt, fully steady. On Thursday October 31st, live bids of \$190/cwt have been renewed in the South.

The US Cattle on Feed Report came out last Friday afternoon and it should be viewed as mostly neutral. October 1st cattle on feed inventories totaled 11.6 million head, the fourth largest since reporting started. Processing margins were positive in September, encouraging larger processing rates. Survey fed cattle marketings were 2% larger than last year. Feedlot placements were 2% lower than last year, whereas pre-report estimates were forecasting a 4% decline. Third quarter feedlot placements are 24,000 head larger than last year; but 99,000 head smaller than the five-year average. Furthermore, October 1st cattle on feed inventories between these three states are 45,000 head larger than last year. This could potentially moderate demand for Canadian fed cattle exports.
